FLOWERS

Plants in Pots or Containers

25. One flowering pot plant in a pot (not exceeding 175mm in diameter)
26. One cactus or succulent, grown in a pot

Hanging Baskets

27. Hanging Basket (maximum 300mm diameter)
Hanging space will be provided

VEGETABLES

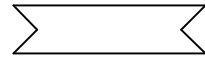
28. Lettuces, cos, two (with washed roots)
29. Any other variety of lettuce, two (with washed roots)
30. Peas (excluding mange-tout), five pods
31. Mange-tout, five pods
32. Radishes, six
33. Brassicas, two (same variety) with 75mm stalk
34. Broad beans, five
35. Onions, green salad, six
36. Onions, four
37. Garlic, 4 bulbs, whole, of uniform size
38. Potatoes, four (same variety)
39. Collection of 3 stems of three different named herbs (in three separate vases)
40. Beetroot, three
41. French beans, nine pods with stalks
42. Courgettes, four, 150mm long with/without flowers
43. Sweetcorn cobs, three
44. Any other vegetable (max. 3 of same variety, named)

DOMESTIC

45. Victoria Sponge
46. Plated Apple Pie
47. Cherry Cake
48. A loaf of hand-made brown bread (not in a machine)
49. A loaf of hand-made white bread (not in a machine)
50. Cheese scones (six)

Definitions:

A bowl is wider than it is high



A vase is higher than it is wide



Conversions:

1 inch = 25.4 mm exactly

Approximately, for guidance:

50 mm = 2 in
75 mm = 3 in
100 mm = 4 in
125 mm = 5 in
150 mm = 6 in
175 mm = 7 in
200 mm = 8 in
300 mm = 12 in
600 mm = 24 in
900 mm = 36 in

Pot and bowl diameters are measured inside the pot
