## FLOWERS

51. Dahlias, one vase or bowl for effect, bowl not to exceed 300mm in diameter
52. One bloom between 220mm - 260mm
53. Dahlias, one vase, three cactus or semi-cactus
54. Dahlias, one vase, five blooms, pompon, not exceeding 52mm
55. For those who have not won a prize for dahlias (novices). One vase, three stems. (Cup presented to first prize winner, provided winner is a CHS Member)
  
56. Roses, large flowered, one vase, three stems
57. Roses, large flowered, one specimen bloom
58. Roses, cluster flowered, one spray

## FRUIT

59. Apples, cooking, four
60. Apples, dessert, four
61. Pears, dessert, four
62. Blackberries, dish of twelve with stalks
63. Plums, six
64. Any other fruit not listed above (max. 6)

## VEGETABLES

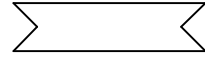
65. Potatoes, white, four
66. Potatoes, coloured, four
67. Carrots, three (with at least 50mm of top)
68. Runner beans, nine pods with stalks
69. Shallots, ten
70. Onions, four (over 250g)
71. Onions, four (250g or under)
72. Tomatoes, one truss some ripe, any kind
73. Tomatoes, five with calyxes attached
74. Tomatoes, yellow, five with calyxes attached
75. Leeks, three (with washed roots)
76. Capsicums (sweet peppers), two
77. Peppers, hot (chilli), two
78. Pumpkin, one
79. Squash, pair
80. Any other vegetable (max. 3 of same variety, named)

## DOMESTIC

81. 1 jar of Lemon Curd
82. 1 jar of soft fruit jam
83. 1 jar of stone fruit jam
84. 1 jar of fruit jelly
85. 1 jar of chutney
86. 1 jar of pickles

### Definitions:

**A bowl** is wider than it is high



**A vase** is higher than it is wide



**Note:** all fruit must have their stalks attached

### Conversions:

1 inch = 25.4 mm exactly

*Approximately, for guidance:*

50 mm = 2 in  
75 mm = 3 in  
100 mm = 4 in  
125 mm = 5 in  
150 mm = 6 in  
175 mm = 7 in  
200 mm = 8 in  
300 mm = 12 in  
600 mm = 24 in  
900 mm = 36 in

*Pot and bowl diameters are measured inside the pot*
